

The Boulder Landscape - a Portal to Spiritual Realms

What: A Geomancy Workshop with Ana Pogačnik

When: May 23rd (starting 7 P.M.) – May 27th (finishing 4 P.M.)

Where: Boulder, Colorado and surrounding area

From Ana: “The Earth is in a process of transformation, and as a result new ways are emerging and opening for humans to support the potential of a landscape. New doors are opening to the deep underlying powers of the Earth and Cosmos, as well as new possibilities and ways to recognize them and bring them into manifestation, making it possible to get into even more heartfelt contact with the beings of the landscape.”

The incredible openness gives this landscape a special meaning in this time of changes. As we more and more lose natural access to the spiritual world, we are seeking a new and deeper connection with it. This landscape is playing a very important role. It can help us to discover anew that as human beings we are spiritual beings. It helps us to find our real home on the Earth... and finally come home.”



“We will visit places that are important for Boulder and its surroundings. Through exercises of perception, guided meditations and toning, we will search for hidden and forgotten qualities of this landscape. We will uncover deeply imprinted memories and riddles that the landscape is carrying and offering to us as mirrors through which we can discover new aspects of ourselves, helping us to recognize, understand and heal unsolved questions about our lives. Most of all, we will use the bridge to the spiritual realms that this landscape is offering to us.”

COSTS:

Tuition: \$275 plus Transportation and Facility Rental: \$75-125 per person (expenses to be shared among participants)

Volunteer drivers and vehicles are needed and might reduce transportation costs.

Gas expenses will be reimbursed. Please contact Gaela if you wish to help.

Lodging and Meals: at Peaceful Meadow Retreat (once the home of Hanna Kroeger, world renowned herbalist and healer, www.peacefulmeadow.com). Total cost per person for a shared room (4 nights) and all organic vegetarian meals (3 dinners, 4 breakfasts) is \$259 plus tax, to be paid on site directly to Peaceful Meadow. Private rooms are available for an additional \$30 per night. Lunches will be purchased by participants at local wholesome markets en route to sites. Locals not requiring accommodations are welcome to commute, and bring or purchase meals at PMR.

Arrival: Closest airport is Denver (DIA). Shuttle service to Boulder is \$13 one way, nearly hourly departures.
